

**Recommended Response Levels:**

(It may be that a number of responses across the levels is required)

<b>Level 0:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- No change in security required</li></ul>
<b>Level 1:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Security awareness</li><li>- Increased vigilance</li><li>- Closing all windows and doors</li><li>- Pre-set numbers in phone (emergency / support)</li><li>- Change routines (be unpredictable)</li><li>- Brief all family members</li><li>- Protect personal information</li></ul>
<b>Level 2:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Physical security increased</li><li>- Ensure locks and latches on all openings</li><li>- Install an intruder alarm</li><li>- Ensure high quality IT security</li></ul>
<b>Level 3:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Use of CCTV – monitored motion detection cameras (Cyclops)</li><li>- Install a panic alarm</li><li>- Security patrols</li><li>- Maintain low profile</li><li>- Personal and/or vehicle GPS tracking</li><li>- Ability to record incoming phone calls to address or mobile</li></ul>
<b>Level 4:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Personal guard (personal protection officer)</li><li>- Distress GPS alarm (personal)</li><li>- Confidential phone numbers</li><li>- Delist vehicle registration numbers to confidential</li><li>- Removed from database lists (e.g. companies)</li></ul>
<b>Level 5:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Relocate to secure address</li></ul>
